Drum Set Jazz Band Requirements for auditions

In addition to the audition piece

Demonstrate: 3 different style beats on the drum set as suggested below.

Swing beat Play in groups of 24 measures with every 8th measure being an appropriate fill for the style beat you are playing. Making **appropriate use** of all drums and cymbals on the drum set will need to be demonstrated when auditioning.

<u>Slow Rock Beat (Ballad)</u> Play in groups of 24 measures with every 8th measure being an appropriate fill for the style beat you are playing. Making <u>appropriate use</u> of all drums and cymbals on the drum set will need to be demonstrated when auditioning.
